"Well Done!" Gathering Group Discussion Questions

Ice Breaker:

Who is someone that has been a blessing to you in the last few months? What did they do?

Question #1: Introduce the sermon by asking someone to read the parable. Then ask:

- What did Greg say was the main point?
- What resonated the most with you?

Question #2: Say something like: "Greg talked about how other voices hinder us from hearing God's voice regarding what we can do. He mentioned Moses and Gideon as examples of two people in the Bible that God called who thought that they could not serve him."

- What are some other voices that compete with God's?
- How does this hinder our ability to serve God with what he has entrusted to us?
- Why is it so easy to fall into the trap of thinking that we can't?

Question #3: Say something like: "Let's look at the three servants a bit more."

- What are the differences between them?
- What did the first two do that the third did not?
- Why is it so easy to fall into the trap of acting like the third servant?

Question #4: Say something like: "The third servant was condemned by the land owner to "weeping and gnashing of teeth."

- Since this isn't a reference to eternal punishment, what does this look like for now?
- How does holding back our gifts from the world lead to such an experience?

Question #5: Say something like: "Let's talk about what God is saying to us."

- What has God called you to offer that if you don't do it then the world will be at a loss?
- Or to put it another way: What has God entrusted to you to offer others?
- How can we support one another in this?
