Moving Forward Gathering Group Discussion Questions

Ice Breaker: Who was your best friend when you were a child?

Question #1: Reflect back on this series.

- What is one thing that has left the most significant impression upon you?
- What does that point mean for your life?

Question #2: In this panel discussion, the theme of being a distinctive Kingdom ambassador was woven through the comments.

- What does it mean to be an ambassador? What are the hallmarks of such a person?
- What might this look like for you as you navigate your social circles?

Question #3: Think about the things that hinder your ability to embrace being a distinctive Kingdom ambassador. This requires honest reflection. We are all dealing with the reality that the love that Jesus offered to all is challenging to emulate.

- What is one thing that hinders you or stands as a roadblock in your path?
- What would it mean for you to trust God with that thing?

Question #4: The panelists talked about the relationship between holding convictions while also being humble. They discussed the importance of resisting evil, but doing so with the love of Christ.

How is this distinctive from the common patterns of this world?

Question #5: No matter the outcome of the election, our ultimate allegiance is to the Kingdom of God.

- What will it look like to love others if your party does not win?
- Or, if you are discussing this after the voting results have been announced, what does it look like if your party has not won?
