Icebreaker: What is your favorite meal?

Question #1: Read Matthew 5:13-16.

- From the various sermons in this series, what has stood out to you the most?
- What has challenged you to change?

Question #2: Reflect on this sermon in particular.

- What is the most significant point from this sermon from your perspective?
- Why does the world need God's people to be salt and light?

Question #3: Dan proposed that we need to be both salt and light, where salt is a metaphor for meeting people where they are, and light a metaphor for pointing the way to God's ideals.

- What happens when we only focus on being salt, that is addressing the realities that people face?
- What happens when we only focus on being light, that is pointing to God's ideals?
