# Congratulations!! Camp Penuel Costa Rica is now a certified Blue Banner Farm!

What does this mean?

The Blue Banner Ecology Program in Costa Rica was founded to improve education and information about the environment. It is a certification program granted every year to those communities, farms and beaches that score at least 90% for all requirements—appropriate use of water, land, fuel and energy, minimizing herbicides/pesticides: preserving water sources; and educating others. The goal of CPCR is to be 100% organically certified over the next 5 years. The award was given to the Camp in June!
