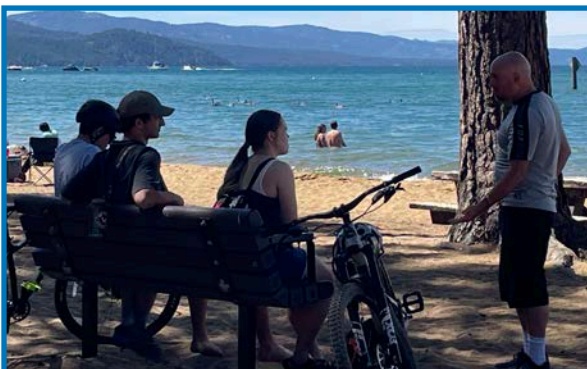
“Would you be willing to talk and answer a few questions about life and spiritual things?”

They were very open to talking, even explaining how they followed Jesus. Except that they were part of the Mormon church. Interestingly, this summer we are studying Galatians. And the main message of Paul in Galatians is that the true gospel, the message he received from Christ, is that all are saved by faith in Jesus alone and that no one should add to this gospel. These two sisters were living proof that many believe a false gospel. Pray for them.
