Jesus is:

- The fulfillment of every promise in the Old Testament. (Matthew 5:17-20; 2 Corinthians 1:19-20; John 1:46; Acts 26:22-23; 1 Peter 1:10-12)
- The Messiah whose death and resurrection culminates God's inspired story. (Luke 24:25-27; 1 Corinthians 15:3)
- The life all Scripture is supposed to lead to. (John 5:39-45)
- The one in whom is hidden all the treasures of God's wisdom. (Colossians 1:1-3; 1 Corinthians 1:18, 24)

Odd Laws

- Cannot plant two different kinds of seed in a field or wear clothing made of two different materials. (Leviticus 20:19)
- No rounding off of the hair on your head or face. (Leviticus 19:27)
- All bodily discharges render a person "unclean" for seven days. Anyone or anything they touch must be cleansed. (Leviticus 15)

Cruel laws

- Capital punishment for homosexuals (Leviticus 20:13) and rebellious children. (Deuteronomy 21:18–21; Exodus 21:15,17; Leviticus 20:9)
- If the daughter of a priest becomes a prostitute, she is to be burned alive, "for she has profaned her father." (Leviticus 21:9)
- Any priest who entered the tabernacle with their hair disheveled, their clothes torn, or after they had drunk any alcohol, was to be stoned to death. (Leviticus 10:6-10)
- If a husband discovers his newly wedded bride is not a virgin, she is to be stoned to death. (Deuteronomy 22:19-21)

Other disturbing things

- Women are the property of males: "You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or male or female slave, or ox, or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor." (Exodus 20:17)
- Slaves are encouraged to endure abuse: "Slaves, accept the authority of your masters with all deference, not only those who are kind and gentle but also those who are harsh. For it is a credit to you if, being aware of God, you endure pain while suffering unjustly." (1 Peter 2:18-21)
- Horrendously violent depictions of God: "Show no mercy". "Utterly destroy them." "Slaughter everything that breathes." (Deuteronomy 7:2; 20:16-17)
