We take the time to teach on the need for people to know Christ and how to share the gospel with others. But on the 2nd morning of the conference, we partner with local churches and send all those students to share the hope of Christ in the surrounding neighborhoods. 65 people indicated decisions to follow Christ at that outreach alone!

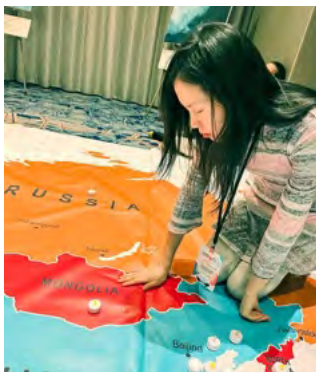


We teach on giving and stewarding their finances and immediately give them an opportunity to give. The student pledged \$34,000 to missions overseas and to humanitarian aid for Hurricane Helene relief! All this happened at just 1 of our 12 Winter Conference locations!



Over four days, students are challenged to live the Spirit-filled life, to go to the world on missions, and to surrender their lives to God. After all, “the surrendered life is the best life possible, because the best life possible is a life in the hands of God.”

A week later, I went to Dallas to help train 320 leaders who will lead over 1800 students on over 100 summer missions this coming summer. Close to 75% of those trips are overseas, including some of the least reached countries in the world.



I look forward to reporting back next month after all 12 winter conferences are completed. Close to 8000 students will attend. Imagine the gospel impact that will happen as a result!
