God Redeems Us To Worship Him

Ex. 9:1-3 Then the LORD said to Moses, "Go to Pharaoh, and say to him, "Thus says the LORD, the God of the Hebrews: Let my people go, so that they may worship me. For it you refuse to let them go... the hand of the LORD will strike with a deadly pestilence...

Ex. 10:3-4 So Moses and Aaron went to Pharoah, and said to him, "Thus says the LORD, the God of the Hebrews, "How long will you refuse to humble yourself before me? Let my people go, so that they may worship me. For if you refuse to let my people go, tomorrow I will bring locusts into your country.

We Worship God Because He Redeemed Us

Ex 15:1-3 Then Moses and the Israelites sand this song to LORD: "I will sing to the LORD, for he has triumphed gloriously... The LORD is my strength and my might, and he has become my salvation; this is my God, and I will praise him, my father's God, and I will exalt him.

The LORD is a warrior!
The LORD is his name!

Ex. 15:20-21 Then the prophet Miriam,
Aaron's sister, took a tambourine in her hand;
and all the women went out after her with
tambourines and with dancing. And Miriam
sang to them:

"Sing to
