
The Only Thing That Counts

IN CHRIST WE ARE...

- * chosen to be holy and blameless in love (Eph. 1:4)
- * give a love nothing can separate us from (Rom. 8:39)
- * given grace before the foundation of the world (2Tim. 1:9 and I Cor 1:4)
- * brought near to God (Eph. 2:13)
- * seated in heavenly places (Eph. 2:6)
- * completely forgiven (Eph. 4:32)

IN CHRIST WE ARE...

- * reconciled to God and had our trespasses cancelled (2Cor. 5:19)
- * set apart and made holy (1Cor. 1:2)
- * receive the righteousness of God (Phil. 3:9)
- * justified (Gal. 2:17)
- * given an eternal inheritance (Eph. 1:11)
- * blessed with every spiritual blessing (Eph. 1:3)
- * made recipients of God's immeasurable riches (Eph. 2:7)
- * taken care of according to God's riches in glory (Phil. 4:19)

IN CHRIST WE ARE...

- * people for whom God is made the sole source of our life (worth, love) (1Cor. 1:30)
- * made alive (1Cor. 15:22)
- * participate in Jesus' own life to God (Rom 6:1-11)
- * established on a firm foundation (2Cor. 1:21)
- * made into a new creation (2Cor. 5:17)
- * have total freedom (Gal. 2:4)
- * made dear children of God (Gal. 3:26)

II. IN CHRIST, THE ONLY THING THAT MATTERS IS *FAITH* ENERGIZED BY LOVE.

III. IN CHRIST, THE ONLY THING THAT MATTERS IS FAITH *ENERGIZED BY LOVE*

- * Let all that you do be done in love. (1Cor. 16:14)
- * live in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us (Eph. 5:2)
- * Above all, clothe yourselves with love (Col. 3:14, cf. I Pet 4:8)
- * the whole law is summed up in a single commandment, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself" (Gal. 5:14).

* If I speak in the tongues of mortals and of angels...have prophetic powers...understand all mysteries and all knowledge...[and]give away all my possessions...but do not have love, I am nothing (I Cor 13:1-3).

* If a brother or sister is naked and lacks daily food, and one of you says to them, "Go in peace; keep warm and eat your fill," and yet you do not supply their bodily needs, what is the good of that? So faith by itself, if it has no works, is dead (Ja 2:15-17).

* For those who want to save their life will lose it, and those who lose their life (*psuche*) for my sake will find it (Matt. 16:25)
