Syn (together, alongside of, with) + **ergy** (energy)

From Greek **sunergos**

Phil. 2:12-13 Therefore, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed me, not only in my presence, but much more now in my absence, work out (**katergazomi**) your own salvation with fear and trembling; for it is God who is at work (**energeo**) in you, enabling you both to will and to work (**energeo**)for (NIV. “act in accordance with”) his good pleasure.

1Cor. 3:9 ...we are God's fellow workers
(*sunergos*)

2Cor. 6:1 As we work together (*sunergeo*) with
him [God], we urge you also not to accept the
grace of God in vain.

2Tim. 2:12 ...if we endure, we will also reign with
