- * “has the power of death” (**Heb 2:14**)


Rom. 8:20 ...for the creation was subjected to futility...in hope that the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to decay and will obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God...the whole creation has been groaning in labor pains until now...

Jesus came to


- * reveal God (**Jn 1:1, 14:8-10; Col 1:15; Heb 1:3**)
- * defeat the devil and his legions (**Heb 2:8; I Jn 3:8; Col. 2:14-15**)
- * restore all of creation (**Rom. 8:20-23; Col. 1:18-20**)
- * save and re-enthrone humans (**Heb 2:8; Rev. 5:10; 2 Tim. 2:12**)

Heb. 2:7-9 You have made them for a little while lower than the angels; “you have crowned them with glory and honor, subjecting all things under their feet.” Now in subjecting all things to them, God left nothing outside their control. As it is, *we do not yet see everything in subjection to them*, but we do see Jesus, who for a little while was made lower than the angels, now crowned with glory and honor because of the suffering of death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone.

Ex. 23:19 The choicest of the first fruits
