So in Christ Jesus you are all children of God through faith.... There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, neither male nor female,


for you are all one in Christ Jesus. If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.



## **Deuteronomy 13:3**
