The Lord condemned the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah by burning them to ashes, and made them an example of what is going to happen to the ungodly...


- "...be like chaff that the wind drives away...the wicked will perish" (Ps. 1:4, 6)
- "...be blotted out of the book of the living..." (Ps. 69:28, cf. Deut. 29:20).
- "...be cut off...and...will be no more" (Ps. 37:9–10).
- "...will perish...like smoke they vanish away" (Ps. 37:20)


10.

- "...shall be altogether destroyed" (Ps. 37:38, cf. vs. 34)
- "...as though they had never been" (Obed. 16)
- "...burn up like chaff with unquenchable fire" (Matt. 3:12)

- consumed (e.g Mt 7:19; 13:40; Jn 15:6; Heb 6:8)
- destroyed (e.g. Mt 7:13; 10:28; I Cor 3:17; Ja 4:12; I Thess 5:3)
- perish (e.g. Jn 3:15-6; 2 Cor 2:15-6)
- death (Rom 6:21-3; Ja 1:15; 5:19; I Tim 1:10)







ACTS 17:27-29
