




### **GENESIS 1:26-27**

#### **GENESIS 2:21-25**

So the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon the man (adam), and he slept; then he took one of his ribs and closed up its place with flesh. And the rib that the LORD God had taken from the man (adam) he made into a woman (ishah) and brought her to the man. Then the man said, "This at last is bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; this one shall be called Woman (ishah), for out of Man (ish) this one was taken." Therefore a man leaves his father and his mother and clings to his wife, and they become one flesh. And the man and his wife were both naked, and were not ashamed.
