



## **GENESIS 1:28-30**






















All painful aspects of nature are the result of the Fall. (Genesis 3:15-19)


"Principalities and Powers" in Apocalyptic thought.

Jesus referred to Satan as "the prince (*archon*) of this world." (John 12:31; 14:30; 16:11), the "prince ruler of the air" (Eph 2:2), the "god of this age" (2 Cor 4:4) who "controls the entire world" (I Jn 5:19)

Satan has power over forces of nature. (Job 1:16,19)

I Jn 3:8 The Son of God "appeared to destroy the works of the devil."

Peter summarizes Jesus' ministry by saying, "He went around doing good and *healing all who were under the power of the devil...*" (Acts 10:38, emphasis added)

Athenagorus said Satan was "the spirit" originally entrusted with "the control of matter and the forms of matter." (*A Plea*, 24). Unfortunately, "the prince of matter [now] exercises a control and management contrary to the good that is in God." (*A Plea*, 25). All suffering and violence in creation is the result of the corrupting influence of an evil "ruling prince" and "the demons his followers." (*A Plea*, 25).
