We release this newsletter amidst the Covid-19 pandemic. It is impacting everything about our ministry. We have staff overseas who have contracted the virus. It has claimed the lives of a few who are part of our church plants. In various places the quarantine rules are much stricter and homes are often the tiniest of flats.

I (Kevin) had an aggressive travel schedule this year. Working with church planters in Moscow, Costa Rica and Australia. Research trips to four new cities (like Cluj and Reykjavik above). All of it is on hold for now. But I am quite busy helping our international field staff answer the question: How shall we then live? - as this blizzard turns into a long winter.

Family News: Kevin continues to work from home and staying active. Kathy has moved her counseling practice home and works via telehealth. As you can imagine, her business is booming. Our family is being very safe as we isolate. Our little home church is doing well meeting virtually.

Prayer Requests:

Pray for our field staff. Some are anxious and traumatized from their local conditions. Others are trying to figure out how to be the presence of Christ to their neighborhood in such times.

Pray for Kathy's counseling ministry. It is intense and important work.
